ME310 Program at Ecole des Ponts ParisTech for students at Tokyo Institute of Technology and University of Tokyo

Requirements

- -Completed a Bachelors Degree and enrolling or enrolled in a Masters Program.
- -Functionally fluency in English (which will be tested during the interview).

Application Process

Letter of intent (why you want to participate in the program)

Transcript

- -Interviews will be scheduled after the applications are submitted (If there are overwhelming number of candidates, first selection will be made before the interviews).
- -Accepted candidates will be announced by early-July.
- -They will have to register to Campus France and confirm their decision by mid-July.

Students are responsible for arranging their own student visa to France (with supporting documents from Ecole des Ponts ParisTech).

Fees

- **-Tuition:** 1,700 euros. This includes travel for project but does not include travel to and from Paris (before and after the program) or living expenses.
- **-Health insurance: 208 euros for one year** (This is mandatory through the French government).
- -Optional complimentary insurance is available for 60~96 or 204 euros (Mutuelle including third party insurance).

Housing

- -Admitted students will receive student housing guarantee at Residence Meunier, 200 meters from the school at current student rental rates (580 euros for studio or 330/390 for double occupancy).
- -Students will also receive public subsidy of about 20% upon application after arrival. Subsidy rate may change depending on the financial situation of each student.

Other

- -Students will receive 58 ECTS upon the completion of the program.
- -The 2012-13 program year will begin in mid-September 2012 and finish in late-June 2013.
- -As the program is in English, there is no required proficiency in French. French courses will be available throughout the year.
